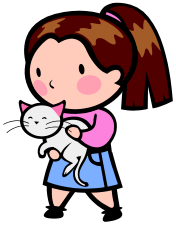

### Ruidoso Dog Park

Location: Next to Sierra Blanca Trail (The Links) off Hull Road and behind the White Mountain Recreational Complex and White Mountain Schools.

There are two fenced areas, one for small dogs, and one for large dogs. Both have water fountains for people and dogs as well as benches.



### Dog Park Rules

While enjoying the dog park, please respect the rules designed to keep people and dogs safe and happy while at the park.

- Dogs must be leashed until safely inside the off-leash area and must be leashed upon exiting.
- Collars and rabies tags must be visible.
- Owners must clean up their dog's waste and dispose of it in the provided trash receptacle
- Owners must be present in the park while their dog is unleashed.
- Owners must carry a leash and remove their dog from the dog park at the first sign of aggression.
- Puppies younger than 4 months, unhealthy dogs and those in heat should be left at home.
- Limit of 3 dogs per owner.
- Food is not allowed.
- Children under 14 years old must be supervised by an adult.
- Please be sensible in supervising your children. If there are dogs present which are unknown to you, please consider changing your plans.
- Be considerate of others. Ensure your dog's inter-action is welcome.
